ATV/UTV Ordinance

The Village has adopted an ATV/UTV ordinance effective April 22, 2019. ATV/UTV's are allowed on all Village Streets except Hwy 45. To see the entire ordinance visit the Village website or contact the Village Clerk. This ordinance may be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce laws of the State of WI, Shawano & Marathon Co., and the Village. Please follow rules respectively. Ordinance can be suspended or revoked by the Village Board at any



time.

The Village has an ordinance in regard to **weed control & lawn care**. Please keep yards maintained. **This includes all property up to the street!** Residents are also reminded that they are responsible for maintaining the sidewalks adjoining their property. This includes removal of snow, ice, sand, grass clippings, toys, etc.



All **cats and dogs** must be **licensed** and are required to be leashed or enclosed in a home or fenced in area. Animals are **not** allowed in any **Village Park**. Please clean up after your animals on sidewalks and personal property.

Permits are needed to use **fireworks** at home.

Sump Pumps

Please remember to check your sump pump and make sure it is hooked up correctly. It is against sewer ordinance to discharge sump pumps into the Village's sewer lines.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDE

Plastic

Accept – all plastic bottles, cups & Containers, household bottles, jars & jugs, Dairy containers & lids, produce, bakery & deli containers & lids (empty, rinse & replace caps & lids)

Do not accept- plastic bags, wrap or film, motor oil bottles, Styrofoam

Paper

Accept – newspapers & inserts, cardboard & paperboard (food boxes), milk, juice & Soup cartons, office & school paper, junk mail & catalogs, phonebooks, books & magazines (shredded paper in a paper bag & staple shut, flatten & cut boxes 2'x2')

Do not accept – tissue paper, pet food bags

Metal

Accept – aluminum bottles & cans, steel & tin cans, empty aerosol cans (empty & rinse)

Do not accept – aluminum pans or foil, empty paint cans, scrap metal

Glass

Accept – Food & beverage bottles & jars (empty & rinse)

Do not accept – window glass, ceramics, china, drinking glasses
