

**VILLAGE OF BIRNAMWOOD**

**ORDINANCE #20-8-3**

**STORAGE/SHIPPING CONTAINER ORDINANCE**

**Section 1 – Purpose**

To address the use of storage / shipping containers when used as an accessory structure for permanent or temporary use.

**Section 2 - Definitions**

Storage / shipping containers are herein defined as any type of container typically used to transport goods via rail, truck and or ship.

**Section 3 – Use of;**

- A. The Village does not and will not allow the placement of a storage/shipping container, as defined in section 2, in any residential area within the Village limits.
  
- B. The Village strongly encourages the use of traditional and conventional building materials i.e. wood, siding, shingles, when placing or constructing a temporary or permanent storage structure.

**Section 4 – Village Building Permit**

A Building permit is required for all storage units, permanent and temporary which are not defined as shipping containers.

**Section 6 – Effective Date**

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The Village clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
