ORDINANCE #20-8-4

WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS

All other Ordinances regarding winter parking are repealed and replaced as follows:

Section 1 - Purpose

To define parking restrictions within the Village during winter months.

Section 2 - Winter Night Parking Restrictions

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on any Village street from November 1st through March 31st, inclusive, between the hours of 1:00 am to 6:00 am

Section 3 - Parking Prohibited During or After Snow Storm

No person shall park any motor vehicle or other apparatus upon any street within the Village during a declared snow emergency until the snow has been removed to the curb or the curb line of such street. Snow emergencies may be declared by the Village President or the Director of Public works when the snow fall of two (2) or more inches has or is predicted to occur. Residents should keep in mind that even if a snow emergency has not been declared, vehicles which are parked overnight on Village streets during snowfalls may hinder snow plowing operations.

Section 4 - Penalties

Any person violating this Ordinance is subject to any or all of the following;

1. Citation issued
2. Forfeiture of not less than \$25 and not more than \$100
3. Towing and impound of vehicle, at owner’s expense

Section 5 - Removal of Vehicles

Any vehicle parked on any street or right-of-way in violation of this Ordinance and in such a manner as to obstruct removal of snow from the street or right-of-way may be removed or caused to be removed to a facility designated by the Village Board.

Said vehicle may not be recovered until the towing, storage and parking forfeitures as imposed by this Ordinance are paid.

Section 6 – Effective Date

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The Village clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
