ORDINANCE # 21-6-28

GARBAGE AND REFUSE COLLECTION ORDINANCE

Section 1 – Purpose

It is the intent of the Village of Birnamwood to provide, through an outside contracted refuse service, both garbage and refuse collection within the Village limits. Service will be provided to one- and two-family units but not to commercial or industrial properties.

Section 3 – Cost of Service

Service is contracted by the Village of Birnamwood board every five years. Providers are encouraged to submit proposal contracts for review by the board. Contracts are awarded by determining the best of both cost to residents and service to be provided.

Section 4 – Collection Time and Day

Collection will be provided for garbage weekly and recycling service will be provided every other week. Collection will be made between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Carts are to be located near the end of the driveway for pickup.

Section 5 – Container and Bundle Regulations

Provided by the contracted service provider, to each unit, will be two 95-gallon containers. One to be used for garbage and one to be used for recycling. Replacement containers will be at the resident's expense in the amount of \$75 each.

Section 7 – Recycling Regulations

(a) Purpose

The purpose of this section is to promote recycling, composting and resource recovery through the administration of an effective recycling program, as provided in ss.159.11, Wis. Stats., and Wis. Adm. Code NR 544.

Section 6 – Items Not to be Picked Up

- (a) Any liquid waste
- (b) Building demo materials (lumber, metal, shingles, siding, etc.)
- (c) Recycling materials mixed with other refuse
- (d) Yard waste
- (e) Asbestos, in any form
- (f) Tires
- (g) Used motor oil
- (h) Hazardous toxic waste
- (i) Chemicals
- (j) Explosives, liquids
- (k) Flammable liquids
- (l) Paint
- (m) Trees and stumps
- (n) Construction debris
- (o) Carcasses
- (p) Medical waste (unless personal needles which shall be properly contained in sharps container)

All recyclables must be in a secured container, no "loose" recycling items will be picked up.

Section 8 – Special Collection

Large household items will be collected once per month at the expense of the resident. Resident must call service provider to schedule a pickup and for pricing.

Section 9 – Billing Payments

The contracted service provider will issue individual invoices to all residents on a quarterly basis.

Section 10 – Mandatory Service

It is understood that by this ordinance of the Village of Birnamwood, subscription to garbage and refuse service is mandated to every one- and two-family units within the Village.

Section 10 – Effective Date

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The Village clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. [60.80](#), Wis. stats.
